Table Showing the Earlier Phasing- in of the WWC Checks for Existing Paid Workers

Existing paid workers who **started before 1 January 2006** and who undertake child-related work in connection with any of the following categories will need to apply by the new dates specified below.

For most people this will mean applying at any time between 1 January 2008 and 31 December 2008, so there will be a whole year to make suitable arrangements.

Category of child-related work	New Phasing-in schedule
<p>Category 1 (i): a child care service – the dates to apply for a WWC Check remains the same for this category unless -</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. you are a paid employee (whether or not of a child care service); and 2. your child-related work is in connection with a child care service; and 3. you have not been the subject of a criminal record check before 1 January 2007 under the Community Services Act 1972 or the Children and Community Services Act 2004 (this may include non-direct care workers for example); and 4. you started before 1 January 2007. 	If the points apply you should apply between 1 January 2008 and the 31 December 2008.
Category 4 (iv): a coaching or private tuition service of any kind, but not including an informal arrangement entered into for private or domestic purposes	Between 1 January 2008 and 31 December 2008.
Category 5 (v): an arrangement for the accommodation or care of children, whether in a residential facility or private residence, but not including an informal arrangement made by a parent of the child concerned or accommodation or care provided by a relative of the child	Between 1 January 2008 and 31 December 2008
Category 7 (vii): the performance by an officer, as defined in the <i>Children and Community Services Act 2004</i> section 3, of a function given to the officer under that Act	Between 1 January 2009 and 31 December 2009
Category 8 (viii): a detention centre, as defined in the <i>Young Offenders Act 1994</i> section 3	Between 1 January 2008 and 31 December 2008
Category 9 (ix): a community child health service	Between 1 January 2008 and 31 December 2008
Category 10 (x): a counselling or other support service	Between 1 January 2008 and 31 December 2008
Category 11 (xi): a religious organisation	Between 1 January 2008 and 31 December 2008
Category 12 (xii): a club, association or movement (including of a cultural, recreational or sporting nature and whether incorporated or not) with a significant membership or involvement of children, but not including an informal arrangement entered into for private or domestic purposes	Between 1 January 2008 and 31 December 2008
Category 14 (xiv): a baby sitting or child minding service, but not including an informal arrangement entered into for private or domestic purposes	Between 1 January 2008 and 31 December 2008
Category 15 (xv): an overnight camp, regardless of the type of accommodation or how many children are involved	Between 1 January 2008 and 31 December 2008
Category 18 (xviii): a children's entertainment or party service;	Between 1 January 2008 and 31 December 2008
